


Foreign Trade in Goods

January 2024

Tirana, February 19, 2024: On January 2024 the value of exports was ALL 29 billion, decreasing by 29.2 % compared with the same period of previous year and by 20.7 % compared with December 2023. The value of imports was ALL 60 billion, increasing by 3.4 % compared with the same period of previous year and decreased by 17.3 % compared with December 2023. This month the trade deficit is ALL 30 billion, increasing by 88.6 % compared with January 2023 and decreasing by -13.5 % compared with December 2023.


Fig.1 Annual change in Foring Trade (%)



The influence of the main groups in the annual change in exports:

In annual decrease of exports by 29.2 % this month, a negative contribution was given by the groups: "Mineral, fuels, electricity" with -19.5 percentage point, "Textile and footwear" with -5.0 percentage point "Construction materials and metals" with -3.8 percentage point, ect. While a negative contribution was, given by the group: "Chemical and plastical products" with +0.3 percentage point and "Food, beverages, tobacco" with +0.1 percentage point.





The influence of the main groups in the annual change in imports:

In annual increase of imports by 3.4 %, this month has mainly affected the groups: "Machinery, equipment and spare parts" with +4.7 percentage point, "Construction materials and metals" with +2.9 percentage point, "Food, beverages, tobacco" with +0.2 percentage point, ect. While a negative contribution was given by the groups: "Mineral, fuels, electricity" with -3.0 percentage point, "Textile and footwear" with -1.0 percentage point, "Leather and leather manufacturing" with -0.3 percentage point, ect.




Fig.3 Contribution of groups in annual change of imports, January 2024


The performance of trade in goods by partner countries

In January 2024, countries with which Albania has had the highest decrease of exports, compared to January 2023 are: Italy (7.6 %), Kosovo (20.1 %) and Germany (34.7 %). While, country with which has had a increase of imports are: Croatia (59.3 %) and Austria (17.6 %).

Në muajin Janar 2024, vendet me të cilët Shqipëria ka pasur rritjen më të madhe te importeve, janë: Italia (2,7 %), Kina (2,1 %) dhe Greqia (36,3 %). Ndërsa vendet me të cilat importet kanë pasur uljen më të madhe, në krahasim me Janar 2023 janë: Turqia (5,6 %), Spanja (16,4%), dhe Maqedonia e Veriut (5,1 %).

In January 2024, countries with which Albania has had the highest increase of imports, compared to January 2023 are: Italy (2.7 %), China (2.1 %) and Greece (36.3 %). While, countries with which has had a decrease of imports are: Turkey (5.6 %), Spain (16.4 %) and North Macedonia (5.1 %).

Trade with the EU countries is 58.4 % of total trade. In January 2024, exports to EU countries occuped 77.8 % of total export and imports from EU countries occuped 48.9 % of total import. The main trade partners remain: Italy (29.7 %), Greece (7.7 %), and Turkey (7.6 %).

Methodology

Exports are goods destined to a third country. placed under customs export or outward processing

arrangements or re-exported following inward processing.

The FOB (free on board) value of exports of goods is the value of the goods at the exporter's customs

frontier.

Imports are goods arrived from a third country and are directly placed. or are left in warehouse. under

customs procedure of release for free circulation. inward processing or processing under customs

control.

The cost. insurance and freight (CIF) price is the price of a good delivered at the frontier of the importing

country. or the price of a service delivered to resident. before the payment of any import duties or other

taxes on imports or trade and transport margins within the country.

Combined Nomenclature (CN) is a goods nomenclature used by international trade in goods statistics

and for customs tariffs.
