

Demographic indicators

Annual 2023 and quarter I - 2024

Tiranë, on 13 May 2024: In 2023, natural population increase is positive with 2,331 births more than deaths, marking an increase compared to the year 2022, which registered 690 births more than deaths.

During the year 2023 were born 23,617 babies, marking a decrease by 4.3 %, compared to the previous year, while the number of deaths was 21,286 persons, marking a decrease by 11.3 %, compared to the previous year.





Fig. 1: Births, deaths and natural increase - annual

Six prefectures of the country recorded positive natural population increase, while in the other six prefectures, the natural population increase was negative.

The prefecture with the highest natural population increase was Tiranë, with 3,548 births more than deaths, while the prefecture with the lowest natural population increase was Korçë, with 760 deaths more than births.


Fig. 2: Births, deaths and natural increase by prefectures - annual 2023



The number of births for the first quarter of 2024 is 5,056, marking a decrease by 6.8 %, compared to the first quarter of 2023, while the number of deaths is 5,537, marking a decrease by 5.2 %, compared to the first quarter of 2023.

The natural population increase in the first quarter of 2024 records 481 deaths more than births.

Fig. 3: Natural population increase, Q1 – 2024*



In the first quarter of 2024, four prefectures of the country record positive natural population increase, while in the other eight prefectures, natural population increase is negative.

In the first quarter of 2024, the prefecture with the highest natural population increase is Tiranë, with 475 births more than deaths, while the prefecture with the lowest natural population increase is Korçë, with 217 deaths more than births.

Births

During the year 2023, three prefectures of the country recorded increase in the number of births, while other nine prefectures recorded decrease, compared to the year 2022.

The highest number of births was recorded in Tiranë prefecture with 8,893 births, while the lowest was recorded in Gjirokastër prefecture with 393 births.

The highest increase in percentage of births, during 2023 compared to 2022, was recorded in Korçë prefecture with 2,3 %, while the highest decrease was recorded in Kukës prefecture with 14.5 %.

In the first quarter 2024, all prefectures of the country record decrease in the number of births, compared to the first quarter 2023.

The highest number of births is recorded in Tiranë prefecture with 1,929 births, while the lowest is recorded in Gjirokastër prefecture with 74 births.

The lowest decrease in percentage of births, during the first quarter 2024, compared to the first quarter 2023, is recorded in Elbasan prefecture with 2.0 %, while the highest decrease is recorded in Vlorë prefecture with 21.1 %.

Deaths

During the year 2023, all prefectures of the country recorded decrease in the number of deaths, compared to the year 2022.

The highest number of deaths was recorded in Tiranë prefecture with 5,345 deaths, while the lowest was recorded in Kukës prefecture with 521 deaths.

The highest decrease in percentage of deaths, during 2023 compared to 2022, was recorded in Fier prefecture with 15.4 %, while the lowest decrease was recorded in Kukës prefecture with 3.7 %.

In the first quarter of 2024, one prefecture of the country recorded increase in the number of deaths, in one prefecture there was no change, while ten other prefectures recorded decrease, compared to the first quarter 2023.

The highest number of deaths is recorded in Tiranë prefecture with 1,454 deaths, while the lowest is recorded in Kukës prefecture with 139 deaths.

The highest decrease in percentage of deaths, during the first quarter 2024, compared to the first quarter 2023, is recorded in Gjirokastër prefecture with 21.4 %, while the lowest decrease is recorded in Tiranë prefecture with 2.6 %.

Methodology

Quarterly data for births and deaths, at national and prefecture level constitute an important link of the demography of the country. They represent data on population changes, which have an impact on the economic and social life of the country. These data are published based on the Official Statistics Program 2023-2026.

Births

Birth data

Data for birth by demographic characteristic are provided by the General Directorate of Civil Status, which sends to INSTAT only the number of births of the residents in Albania.

All births of Albanian residents are considered during the reference period, by not taking into account the births of residents outside Albania (emigrants), even though they may be registered in the civil status offices, near their former settlements.

Late registered birth

A small adjustment is made in the number of the late registered births for the actual year, in order to include all occurred births in a reference period.

The number of late registered births, from the previous year are considered as proxy for late registration of the actual year, considering the assumption (as a result of our continuous analyses) that the number of late registered births does not change a lot from year to year.

Deaths

Death data

Data for deaths by demographic characteristic are provided by the General Directorate of Civil Status, which send to INSTAT only the number of deaths of the residents in Albania.

All deaths of Albanian residents are considered during a reference period, by not taking into account the deaths of residents outside Albania (emigrants), although they may be registered in the civil status offices near their former settlements.

Late registered death

We make a small adjustment in the number of the late registered deaths for the actual year, in order to include all occurred deaths in a reference period.

The number of late registered deaths, from the previous year is considered as proxy for late registration of the actual year, considering the assumption (as a result of our continuous analyses) that the number of late registered deaths doesn't change a lot from year to year.

Definitions:

Natural population increase: Expresses the increase/decrease of the population, as a result of the biological processes (births and deaths), over a period of time.

It is expressed as the difference between the live births to deaths.

Live birth: Births of children that showed any sign of life.

Death: Means the permanent disappearance of all evidence of life, at any time after life birth has taken place (postnatal cessation of vital functions without capability of resuscitation).
