


Foreign Trade in Goods

May 2024

Tirana, June 18, 2024: On May 2024 the value of exports was ALL 35 billion, decreasing by -12.4 % compared with the same period of previous year and increasing by 0.5 % compared with April 2024. The value of imports was ALL 79 billion, decreasing by -1.6 % compared with the same period of previous year and increasing by 5.3 % compared with April 2024. This month the trade deficit is ALL 45 billion, increasing by 8.9 % compared with May 2023 and by 9.4 % compared with April 2024.






In the first five months of 2024, the value of exports was ALL 165 billion, decreasing by -16.1 %, compared with previous year and the value of imports was ALL 364 billion, decreasing by -0.02 % compared with previous year. Trade deficit was ALL 199 billion, increasing by 18.9 % compared with the same period of 2023.

The influence of the main groups in the annual change in exports:

In annual decrease of exports by -12.4 % this month, a negative contribution was given by the groups: "Textile and footwear" with -7.6 percentage point, "Food, beverages, tobacco" with -2.7 percentage point, "Chemical and plastical products" with -0.7 percentage point, ect. While a positive contribution was given by the group: "Mineral, fuels, electricity" with +0.4 percentage point.

Fig.2 Contribution of groups in annual change of exports May 2024




Exports during the five months of 2024 are decreased by -16.1 % compared with the same period of previous year. The main groups that influenced more in annual decrease of exports are: "Mineral, fuels, electricity" with -6.1 percentage point, "Textile and footwear" with -5.6 percentage point, "Constructions materials and metals" with -2.4 percentage point, ect.

The influence of the main groups in the annual change in imports:

In annual decrease of imports by -1.6 %, this month has mainly affected the groups: "Mineral, fuels, electricity" with -3.1 percentage point, "Textile and footwear" with -1.6 percentage point, "Chemical and plastical products" with -0.8 percentage point, ect. While a positive contribution was given by the groups: "Machinery, equipment and spare parts" with +2.1 percentage point, "Constructions materials and metals" with +1.0 percentage point, and "Food, beverages, tobacco" with +0.6 percentage point.

In the first five months of 2024, imports are decreased by -0.02 % compared with the same period of previous year. The groups affected negativity in annual decrease of imports, are: "Minerals, fuels, electricity" with -2.2 percentage point, "Textile and footwear" with -1.4 percentage point, "Constructions materials and metals" with -0.5 percentage point, ect. While a positive contribution was given by the groups: "Machinery, equipment and spare parts" with +3.5 percentage point and "Food, beverages, tobacco" with +1.2 percentage point.

The performance of trade in goods by partner countries


In May 2024, countries with which Albania has had the highest increase of exports, compared to May 2023 are: Kosovo (3,9 %), North Macedonia (20.0 %), China (80.5 %), ect. While, countries with which has had a decrease of imports are: Italy (23.7 %), Greece (2.7 %), and Germany (1.5 %).

In the first five months of 2024, countries with which Albania has had a increase of exports, compared to the same period of 2023 is: China (34.9 %). While, country with which has had a decrease of exports are: Italy (15.6 %), Kosovo (2.6 %) and Greece (26.6 %).

In May 2024, countries with which Albania has had the highest increase of imports, compared to May 2023 are: Turkey (17.3 %), Greece (4.2 %) and Spain (1.9 %). While, countries with which has had a decrease of imports are: Italy (3.2 %), China (23.2 %) and Germany (6.8 %).

In the first five months of 2024, countries with which Albania has had the highest increase of imports, compared to the same period of 2023 are: Turkey (21.4 %), Greece (18.4 %), and Germany (5.0 %). While, countries with which has had a decrease of imports are: Italy (5.0 %), China (11.1 %), and North Macedonia (15.1 %).

Trade with the EU countries is 57.3 % of total trade. In May 2024, exports to EU countries occuped 68.2 % of total export and imports from EU countries occuped 52.2 % of total import. The main trade partners remain: Italy (28.5 %), China (7.4 %), Turkey (7.4 %), and Greece (7.2 %).

Trade with the EU countries, in the first five months of 2024 is 58.4 % of total trade. In this period, the share of exports to EU countries was 72.0 % of total export and share of imports from EU countries was 52.2 % of total import. The main trade partners are: Italy (28.8 %), Turkey (8.9 %), Greece (7.3 %) and China (7.2 %).

Methodology

Exports are goods destined to a third country. placed under customs export or outward processing arrangements or re-exported following inward processing.

The FOB (free on board) value of exports of goods is the value of the goods at the exporter's customs frontier.

Imports are goods arrived from a third country and are directly placed. or are left in warehouse. under customs procedure of release for free circulation. inward processing or processing under customs control.

The cost. insurance and freight (CIF) price is the price of a good delivered at the frontier of the importing country. or the price of a service delivered to resident. before the payment of any import duties or other taxes on imports or trade and transport margins within the country.

Combined Nomenclature (CN) is a goods nomenclature used by international trade in goods statistics and for customs tariffs.
