

## **Air Transport Statistics**

## Second Quarter, 2024

Tirana, 30 July 2024: In air transport, operate 25 airlines, of which 24 are foreign companies and 1 is Albanian companies. During the second quarter of 2024, 102,916 aircrafts have flown in the Albanian airspace, of which 81.9 % were overpasses.



The volume of loaded and unloaded freights (including air mail) via air transport is 560.8 tons, of which 74.2 % are loaded and 25.8 % are unloaded freights. Compared to the second quarter of 2023, the volume of freights increased by 12.7 %.

In air transport, goods transported by mail account for 9.7 % of the total volume of goods transported by air. The volume of mail decreased by 12.6 %, compared to the second quarter of 2023.

In the second quarter of 2024, 2,879,158 passengers traveled by airline from 1,747,887 passengers compared to the same period of the previous year, increasing by 64.7 %.

## Exports/Imports of freights by air transport

In the second quarter of 2024, the volume of goods traded by air (exports and imports) is 571 tonnes. Compared to the same period of 2023 this indicator increased by 47.8 %. The volume of goods imported by air in the second quarter of 2024 accounts 0.02 % of the total volume of imported goods.




Fig. 3: Export/import of freights by air

# Methodology

The publication of Transport Statistics presents the results on the transport of goods and passengers as well as the export and import of goods according to the mode of transport on a monthly basis. The data of the publication are obtained from administrative sources. The main source of information is the data reported from the Ministry of Infrastructure and Energy and the General Directorate of Customs.

#### **Definitions**

**Transport**: Movement of people and / or freights using various means of transport. Transport is carried out by rail, land, sea and air.

**Air transport**: Any movement of freights and / or passengers using aircraft on trips, which are undertaken wholly or partly by air

**Airport:** A designated area of land or water (including buildings, installations and equipment) intended to be used either in whole or in part for the arrival, departure and surface movement of aircraft and open to commercial air transport operations.

**Airline:** An aviation enterprise operating aircraft for commercial purposes that (i) performs scheduled air transport services, or both, which are publicly available for the carriage of passengers, mail, and / or cargo, and (ii) has been certified for such purposes by the civil aviation authority of the State in which it is established. **Passenger Air Service:** Scheduled or non-scheduled air service performed by aircraft carrying one or more arriving passengers and any flight listed in published schedules as open to passengers.

**Air cargo and mail service:** Scheduled or non-scheduled air service performed by aircraft carrying incoming cargo (freight and mail), other than passengers.

**Flight Number:** It's the first published initial number assigned by the air transport operator to the flight. Passengers using a flight from an aircraft may travel under a number of different flight numbers.

Carried passengers: All passengers whose journey begins or ends at the reporting airport are called.

**Transported freights:** Includes any cargo loaded onto or unloaded from an aircraft, excluding passenger baggage and mail.

**Exports**: Goods destined to a third country, placed under customs export or outward processing arrangements or re-exported following inward processing.

**Imports**: Goods arrived from a third country and are directly placed, or are left in warehouse, under customs procedure of release for free circulation, inward processing or processing under customs control. **Nomenclature of Transport Statistics (NST 2007)**: A statistical nomenclature for the goods transported by four modes of transport: road, rail, inland waterways and sea (maritime).
