


Foreign Trade in Goods

December 2024

Tirana, January 17, 2025: On December 2024 the value of exports was ALL 26 billion, decreasing by -31.7 %, compared with the same period of previous year and decreasing by -14.8 %, compared with November 2024. The value of imports was ALL 79 billion, increasing by 8.3 %, compared with the previous year and increasing by 7.9 %, compared with November 2024. This month the trade deficit is ALL 53 billion, increasing by 51.1 %, compared with December 2023 and increasing by 23.8 %, compared with November 2024.

Fig. 1 Annual change in Foring Trade (%)




During 2024, the value of exports was ALL 373 billion, decreasing by -15.4 %, compared with previous year and the value of imports was ALL 894 billion, increasing by 2.5 %, compared with previous year. Trade deficit was ALL 522 billion, increasing by 20.7 %, compared with 2023.

The influence of the main groups in the annual change in exports:

In annual decrease of exports by -31.7 % this month, a contribution was given by the groups: "Constructions materials and metals" with -18.9 percentage point, "Minerals, fuels, electricity" with -6.6 percentage point, "Textile and footwear" with -4.8 percentage point, etc. While a positive contribution was given by the group: "Food, beverages, tobacco" with +0.3 percentage point.






Exports during 2024 are decreased by -15.4 %, compared with previous year. The main groups that influenced more in annual decrease of exports are: "Minerals, fuels, electricity" with -5.3 percentage point, "Textile and footwear" with -4.8 percentage point, "Constructions materials and metals" with -4.1 percentage point.

The influence of the main groups in the annual change in imports:

In December 2024 the increasing of imports by +8.3 %, compared with the same month of the previous year, was positively affected by the groups: "Machinery, equipment and spare parts" with +5.2 percentage point, "Minerals, fuels, electricity" with +1.5 percentage point, "Food, beverages, tobacco" with +1.4 percentage point. While a negative contribution was given by the groups: "Constructions materials and metals" with -2.0 percentage point, "Textile and footwear" with -0.2 percentage point, "Leather and leather manuf." with -0.3 percentage point.

During 2024, imports are increased by 2.5 %, compared with previous year. The groups affected positively in annual increase of imports, are: "Machinery, equipment and spare parts" with +2.9 percentage point, "Food, beverages, tobacco" with +1.2 percentage point. While a negative contribution was given by the groups: "Minerals, fuels, electricity" with -1.0 percentage point, "Textile and footwear" with -0.9 percentage point, "Constructions materials and metals" with -0.3 percentage point.

The performance of trade in goods by partner countries

In December 2024, countries with which Albania has had the highest decrease of exports, compared to December 2023 are: Italy (18.0 %), Kosovo (15.8 %), Greece (8.4 %), etj. While, countries with which has had an increase of exports are: North Macedonia (17,3 %), Turkey (60,5 %), United Kingdom (37,4 %).


During 2024, countries with which Albania has had the highest decrease of exports, compared to 2023 are: Italy (13.9 %), Kosovo (9.8 %), Greece (18.2 %), etc. While, countries with which has had an increase of exports are: China (3.5 %), etc.

In December 2024, countries with which Albania has had the highest increase of imports, compared to December 2023 are: : Italy (2.4 %), China (33.3%), Turkey (8.2 %), etc. While, countries with which has had a decrease of imports are North Macedonia (16.4 %), Switzerland (15.7%), Austria (19.1 %), etc.

During 2024, countries with which Albania has had the highest increase of imports, compared to 2023 are: China (4.2 %), Turkey (14.2 %), Greece (19.7 %), etc. While, countries with which has had a decrease of imports are: Italy (2.3 %), North Macedonia (14.9%), Switzerland (29.8%), etc.

Trade with the EU countries is $55.5\,\%$ of total trade. In December 2024, exports to EU countries occupied $70.8\,\%$ of total exports and imports from EU countries occupied $50.5\,\%$ of total imports.

The main trade partners remain: Italy (25.1 %), China (10.4 %), Turkey (8.2%), Greece (7.4 %) .

Trade with the EU countries, for 2024 is 57.4 % of total trade. During this year, the share of exports to EU countries was 71.7 % of total exports and share of imports from EU contries was 51.5 % of total imports. The main trade partners are: Italy (27.8 %), China (8.5 %), Turkey (8.0 %) and Greece (7.2 %).

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Methodology

Exports are goods destined to a third country, placed under customs export or outward processing

arrangements or re-exported following inward processing.

The FOB (free on board) value of exports of goods is the value of the goods at the exporter's customs

frontier.

Imports are goods arrived from a third country and are directly placed, or are left in warehouse, under

customs procedure of release for free circulation, inward processing or processing under customs control.

The cost, insurance and freight (CIF) price is the price of a good delivered at the frontier of the importing

country, or the price of a service delivered to resident, before the payment of any import duties or other

taxes on imports or trade and transport margins within the country.

Combined Nomenclature (CN) is a goods nomenclature used by international trade in goods statistics

and for customs tariffs.

Ireland, Greece, Spain, Portugal, Austria, Finland, Sweden, Cyprus, Czech Republic, Estonia, Hungary,
