

Rail Transport Statistics

Second quarter, 2025

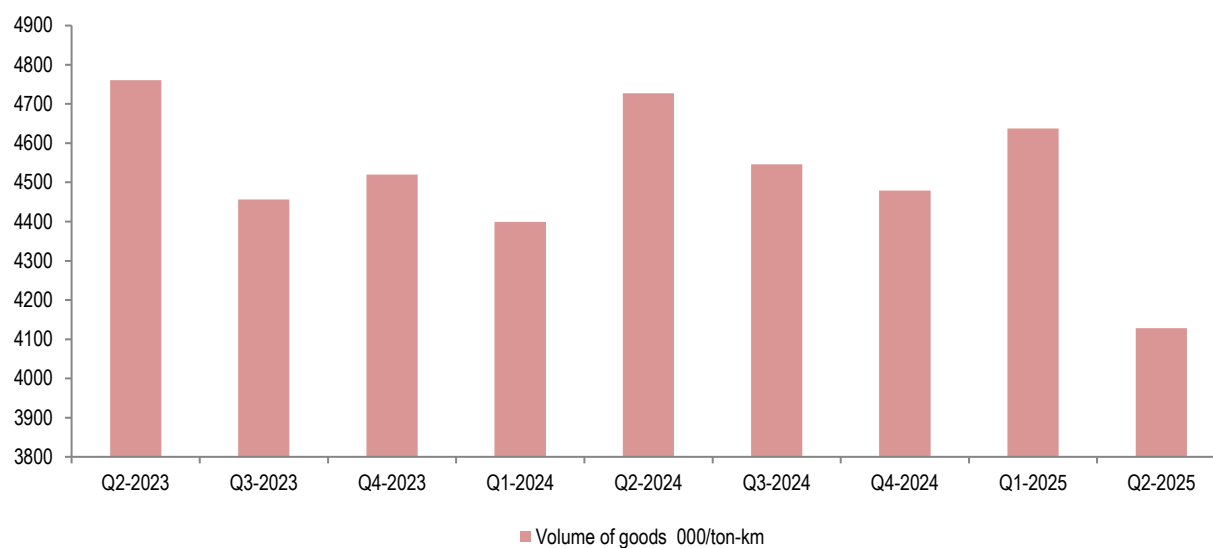
Tirana, 30 July 2025: The length of the railway network in use in Albania is 253 km. The railways lines, currently in use, are as follows: Borderline-Gjorm with a length of 93 km, Durrës-Elbasan with a length of 76 km, Rrogozhinë-Fier with a length of 49 km, Fier-Vlorë of 35 km. Rail transport of freights is carried out at distances of 0-49 km.

Rail Transport Statistics, for the second quarter of 2025, are presented as follows:

The volume of goods transported by rail is 120.2 thousand tons, decreasing by 16.1 %, compared to the second quarter of 2024.

The volume of goods transported by rail is 4,128 thousand ton-km from 4,728 thousand ton-km in the same peirod of the previous year, decreasing by 12.7 %.

“Coal and lignite, crude oil and natural gas” according to the NST 2007 classification (Nomenclature of Transport Statistics), account for 97.0 % of freights transported by rail for the second quarter of 2025, “Secondary raw materials; municipal wastes and other wastes” account for 3.0 % (tab.1).

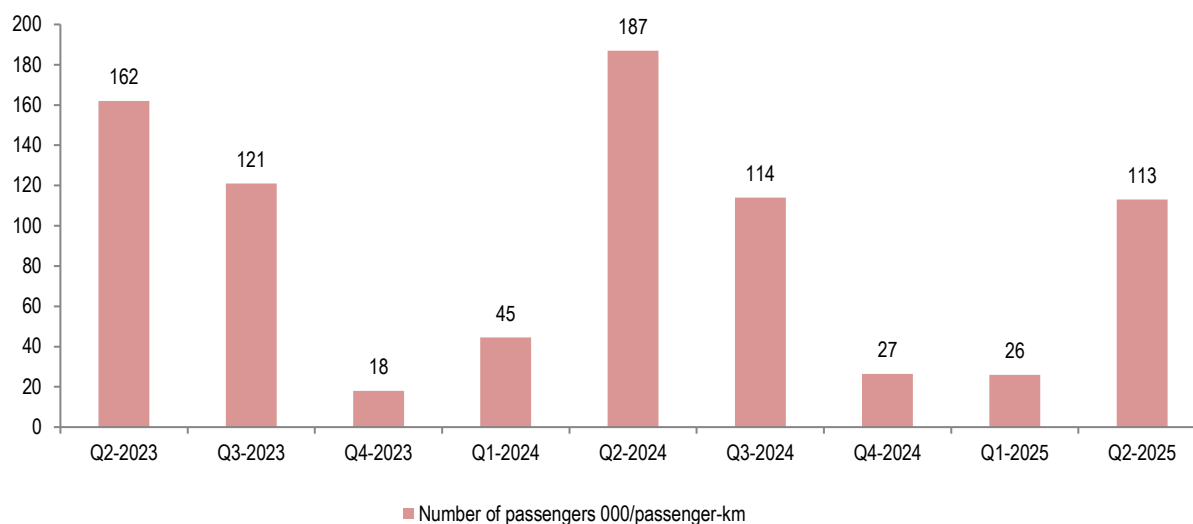

During the second quarter of 2025, 2,609 passengers used rail transport as a means of travel, where compared to the same period last year, the number of passengers traveled with this type of transport decreasing by 36.2 %.

Methodology

The Transport Statistics publication presents the results on the transport of goods and passengers by type, as well as the export and import of goods by mode of transport, on a monthly basis. The data are administrative. The main source of information is the Ministry of Infrastructure and Energy and General Directorate of Customs.

Definitions

Transport: Movement of people and / or freights using various means of transport. Transport is carried out by rail, land, sea and air.

Rail transport: Any movement of freights and/passengers using wheeled vehicles running on rails.

Length of train tracks: For a given railways section it is the length between the midpoint of the departure station building and the midpoint of the terminal station building.

Rail Passengers: Any passenger traveling by rail vehicle, excluding persons intended for services on the train.

Ton per kilometre (TKM): The unit of measurement representing the movement of one ton of available capacity in a wagon when performing services for which a distance of mainly over one kilometre is determined.

Freights transported by rail: Any movement of freights carried out by rail, including packaging and equipment such as containers, pallets and road vehicles of freights transported by rail.

Train- kilometre: are the distances in kilometre travelled by trains.

Exports: Goods destined to a second country, placed under customs export or outward processing arrangements or re-exported following inward processing.

Imports: Goods arrived from a second country and are directly placed, or are left in warehouse, under customs procedure of release for free circulation, inward processing or processing under customs control.

Nomenclature of Transport Statistics (NST 2007): A statistical nomenclature for the goods transported by four modes of transport: road, rail, inland waterways and sea (maritime).
