

Road accidents*

January 2025

Tirana, 28 February 2025: In January 2025, are counted 125 road accidents from which 174 persons were casualties (killed an injured). * (The data published is preliminary and subject of updating).

During the period January 2025, the number of road accidents decreased by 22.8%, compared to the same period a year earlier.

The road accidents, in 89.6 % of cases, occurred as a result of the driver's behavior. The highest number of accidents, in this period, was carried out by the age group 0-24 and 25-34 year, accounting 21.6 % of the total number of accidents.



Page 2 Road accidents January 2025

In January 2025, the highest number of road accidents occurred on Thursday by 23.2 %, while the lowest number of accidents occurred on Saturday by 10.4 %.

Methodology

The purpose of the monthly publication of accidents is to present the results and indicators of road accidents such as: the change in the number of monthly accidents. number of killed and injured persons by road accidents classified by gender, the behavior of road users, age and counties in the country comparing with the same period a year ago. The General Directorate of State Police is the institution that provides INSTAT with a comprehensive system of information on road accidents.

Definitions

Accidents: Unwanted or unintended sudden event or a specific chain of such events which have harmful consequences.

Injury accident: Any accident involving at least one road vehicle in motion on a public road or private road to which the public has right of access, resulting in at least one injured or killed person.

Person killed: It is considered any person killed immediately or dying within 30 days as a result of the accident, excluding suicides.

Person injured: Any person who as result of an accident was not killed immediately or not dying within 30 days, but sustained an injury, normally needing medical treatment, excluding attempted suicides.

The behavior of the driver: It implies when the driver does not comply with the traffic rules according to the "Road Code" as sudden braking, ignores signs (signaling) traffic, disregard the speed limit, etc.

Pedestrian Behavior: It implies when pedestrian does not comply with the traffic rules according to the "Road Code" as crossing the road carelessly, etc.

Source of data: The data are provided by Ministry of Internal Affairs/General directorate of State's Police.

The data of a last month on killed persons by road accidents are preliminary and subject of revision. For more: <u>Statistical Revision Policy</u>.
